D&S Team Update:

The Discernment & Search Team met on August 29 with Diocesan Deployment Officer Judy Fried. She gave us feedback from some of the candidates in the first phase of our discernment and search for our tenth rector. The diocese has received some inquiries and applications for our re-opened position. After the bishop reviews the applications and approves these candidates, we will begin reviewing their files. We expect to receive additional applications after the semi-annual Transitional Ministry Conference which Judy will attend in late September.

The Team is reviewing the goals and descriptions of our parish and the language used as we describe ourselves on our web site and in our printed materials. Our next meetings will also focus on reviewing the questions we ask candidates in our phone conversations.
